

RESOLUTION NO. 21-

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAMMOTH LAKES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, TERMINATING THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY AS PROVIDED FOR IN RESOLUTION NO. 20-10 ADOPTED ON MARCH 18, 2020

WHEREAS, a local emergency existed in the Town of Mammoth Lakes in accordance with Resolution No. 20-10 adopted by the Town Council on March 18, 2021 as a result of conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property and fiscal impact caused by the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within the Town of Mammoth Lakes; and

WHEREAS, it now appears that local health providers including Mammoth Hospital, Mammoth County Public Health, and other providers can meet the medical demands of the Town of Mammoth Lakes, such that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property no longer exist; and

WHEREAS, the financial planning, resources management, and budgeting by the Town of Mammoth and the opening of the local economy has provided stability in the Town's financial condition, such that conditions of extreme peril to the Town's fiscal stability no longer exist; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 8630 authorizes the declaration of local emergencies, and requires a town's governing body to proclaim the termination of the local emergency at the earliest possible date that conditions warrant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the local emergency declared by the Mammoth Lakes Town Council by Resolution 20-10 on March 18, 2020, is hereby terminated, provided that such termination shall not affect the authority of the Town or any officer or employee thereof to act in accordance with any state of emergency declared by the State of California or Governor of California, and/or any executive orders or public health orders issued in connection with such emergency.
