



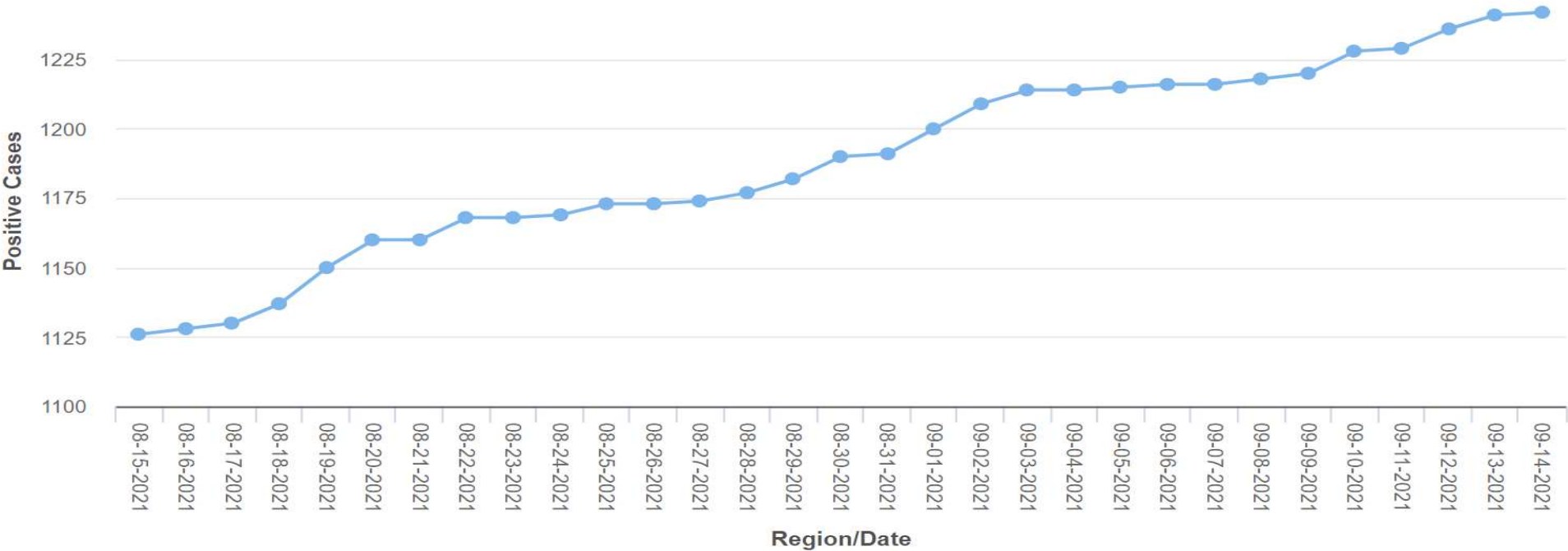

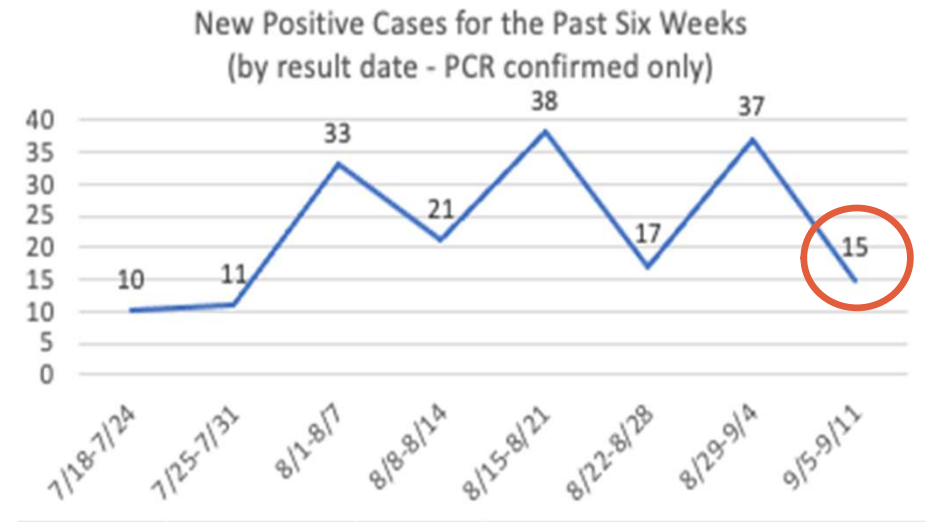
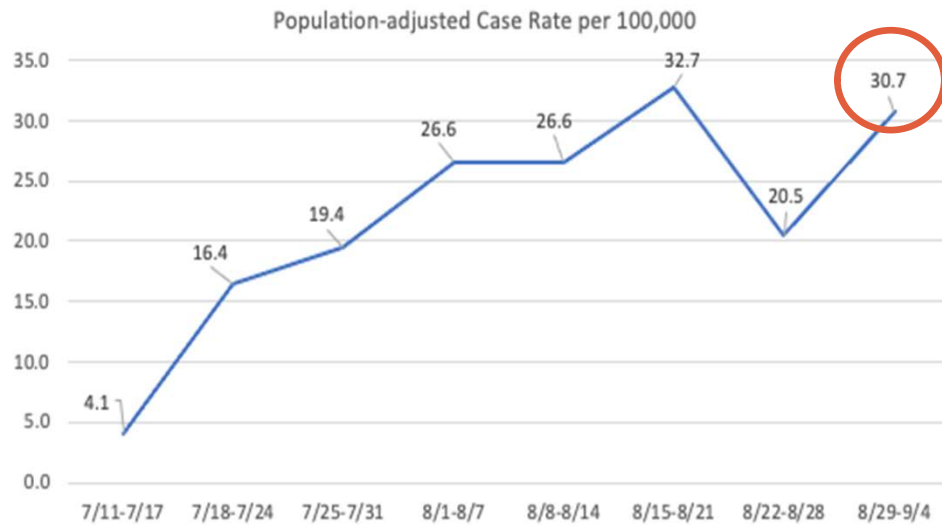


Total Positive Cases for Mono County Residents (last 30 d...

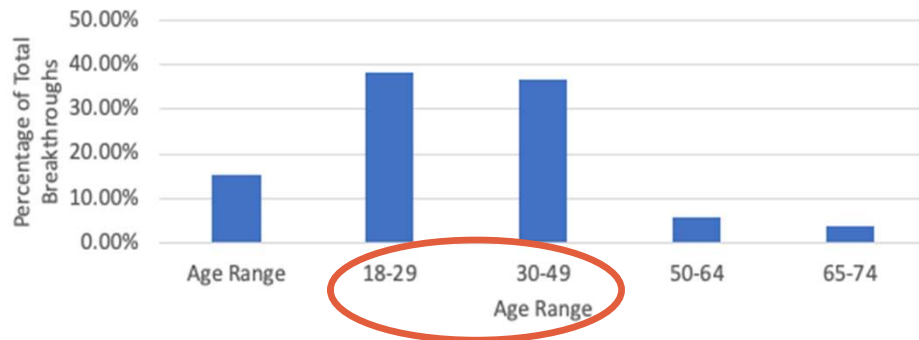

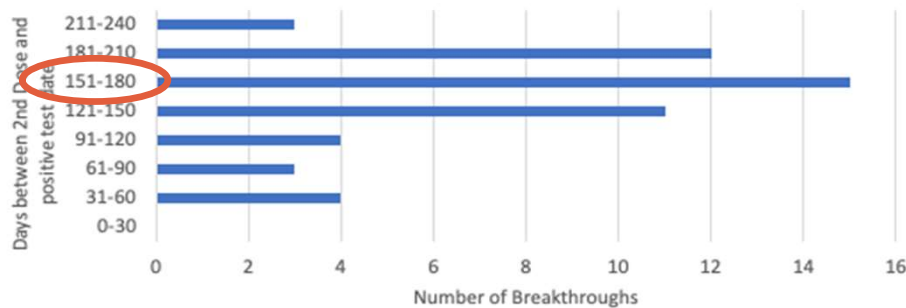

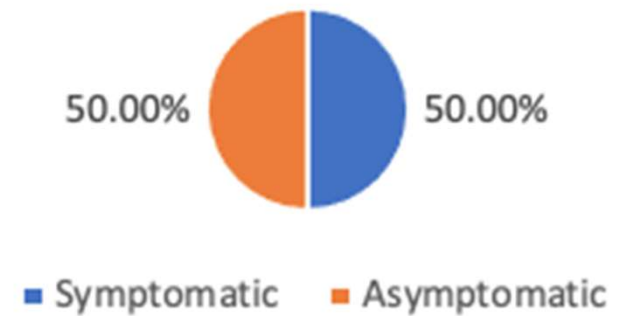

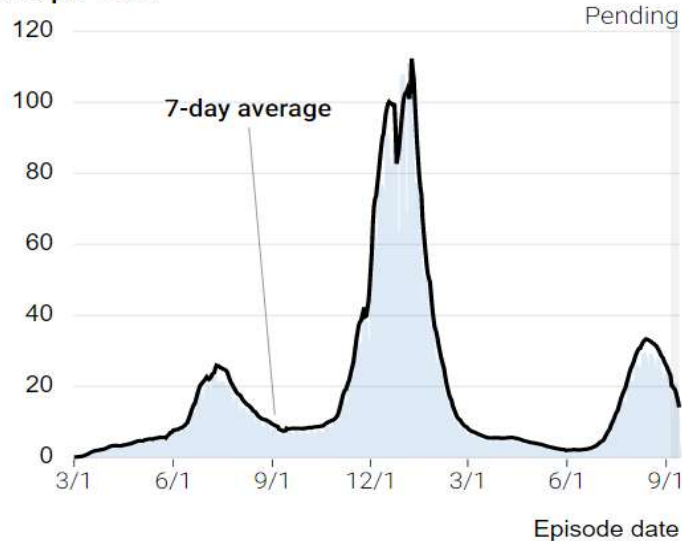

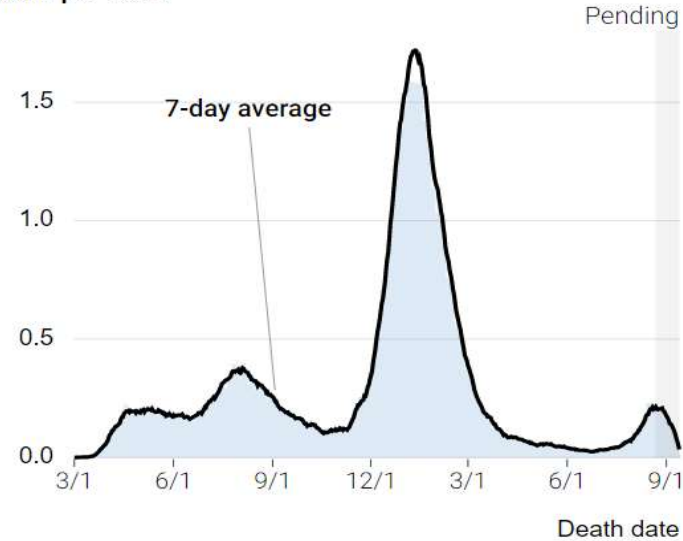

Third Doses of COVID-19 Vaccines

- On August 12, the FDA expanded the emergency use authorization for both mRNA vaccines, Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna, for immunocompromised individuals.
- This authorization covers ages 12 and up who are receiving treatments that are associated with moderate to severe immune compromise.

FDA Approval of Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine

- On August 23, the FDA approved the first COVID-19 vaccine.
- The vaccine has been known as the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine and will now be marketed as Comirnaty (koe-mir'-na-tee), for the prevention of COVID-19 disease in individuals 16 years of age and older.
- The vaccine also continues to be available under emergency use authorization (EUA), including for individuals 12 through 15 years of age and for the administration of a third dose in certain immunocompromised individuals.

Day of vaccination



- Bring a form of documentation with your name that matches the name on your appointment. Acceptable forms include: a driver's license, pay stub or utility bill.
- If your vaccine requires a second dose, ask when it will be scheduled.
- Prepare to wait 15-30 minutes after your shot to make sure you don't have a reaction to the vaccine.
- After your shot make sure to get your vaccination card.

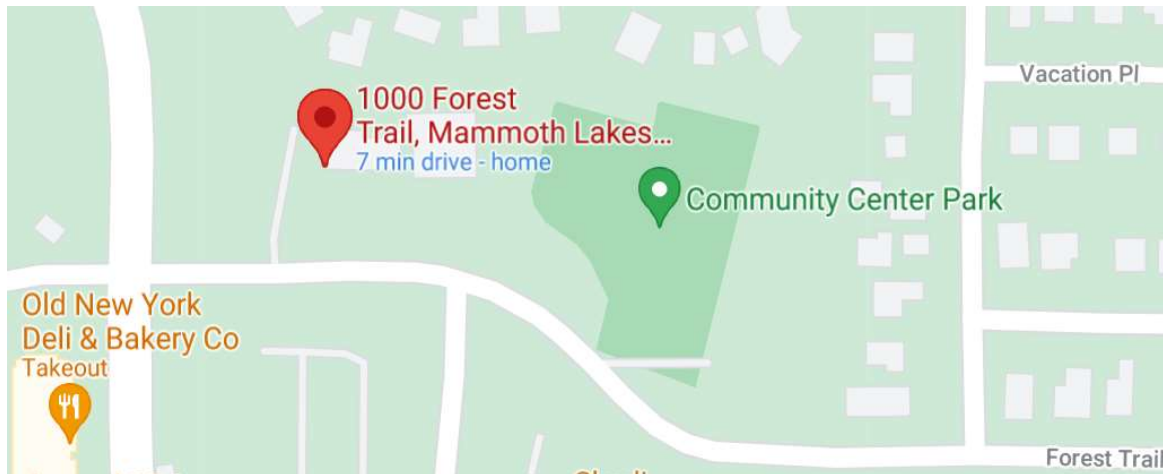
OPTUMSERVE COVID-19 TESTING

FREE MONO COUNTY COVID-19 TESTING – MAMMOTH LAKES



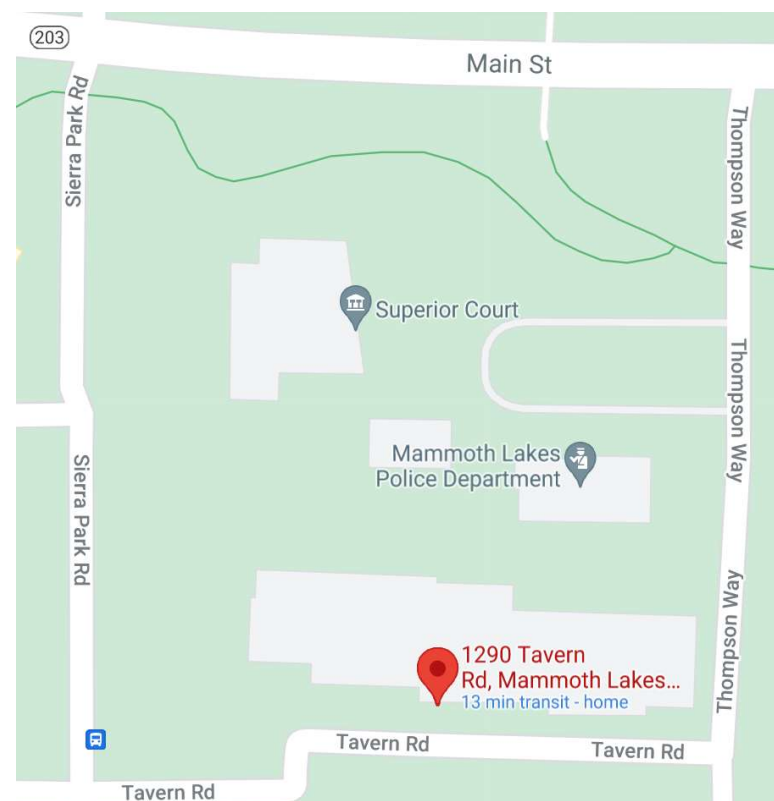
Mono County Public Health is offering testing from the Public Health offices in Mammoth Lakes each week.
