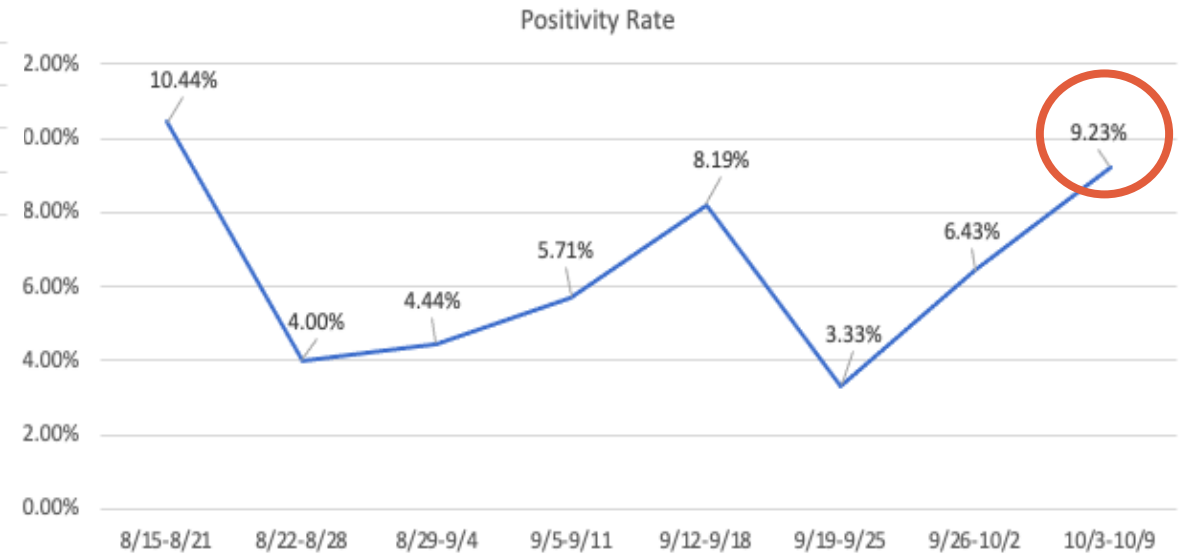

## Total Positive Cases for Mono County Residents (last 30 d...



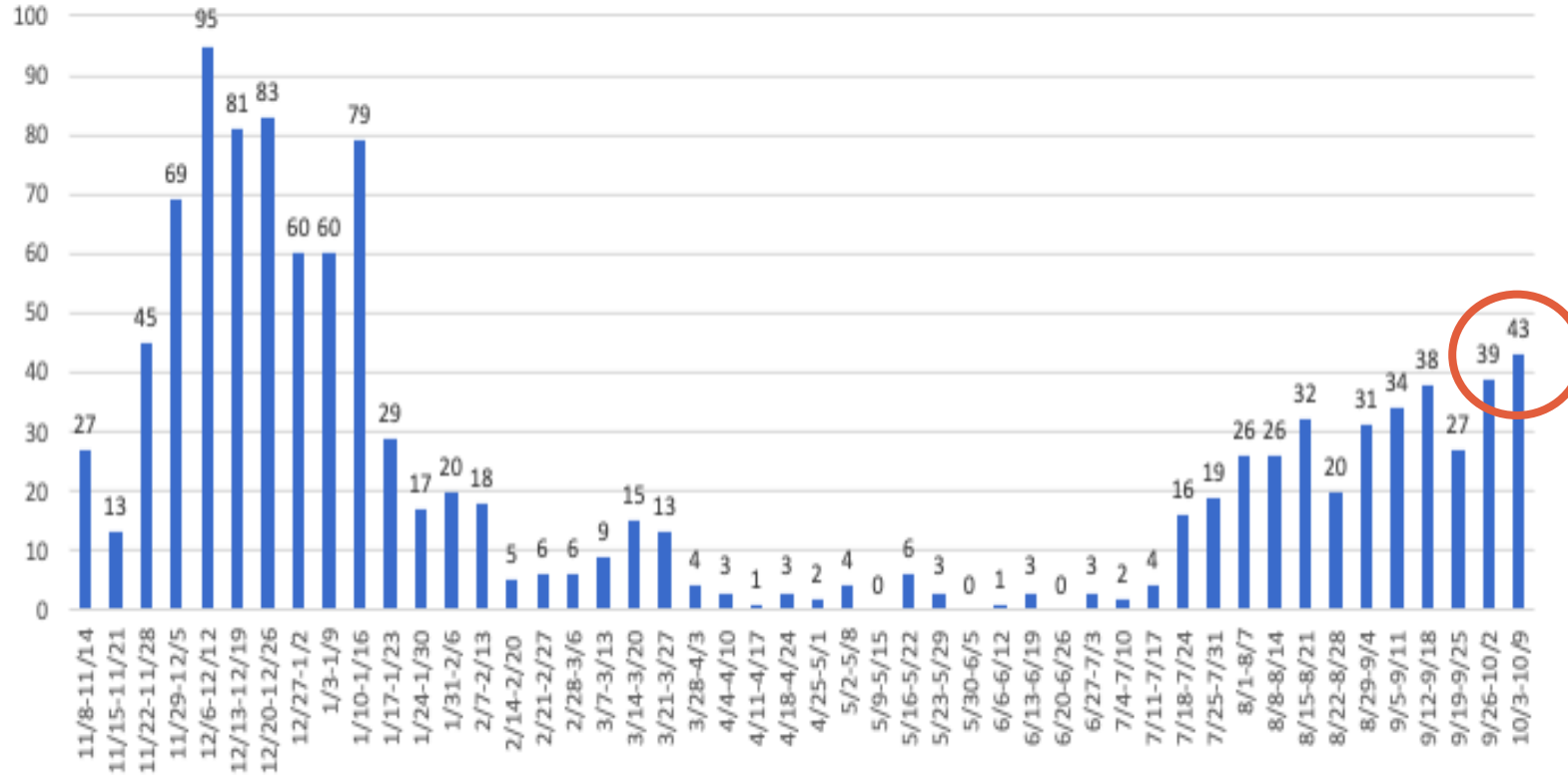

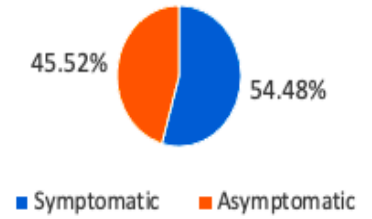

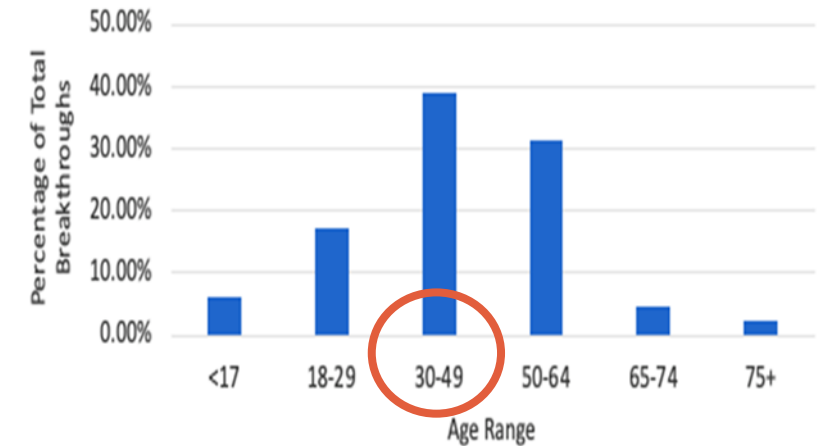
New Positive Cases per Week

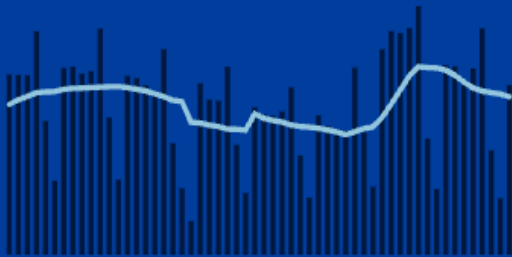

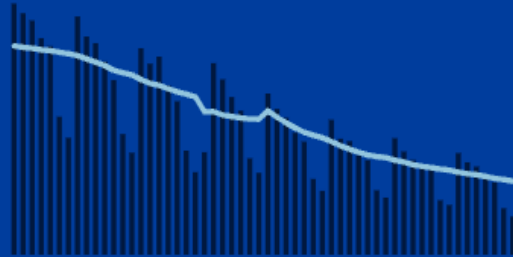

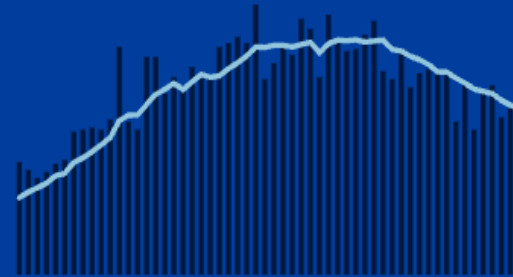

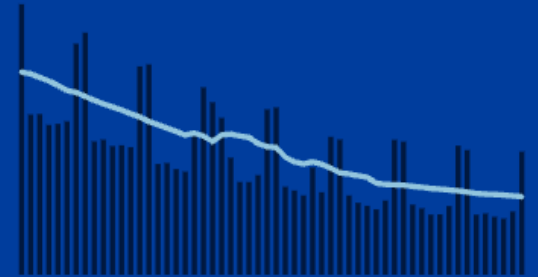

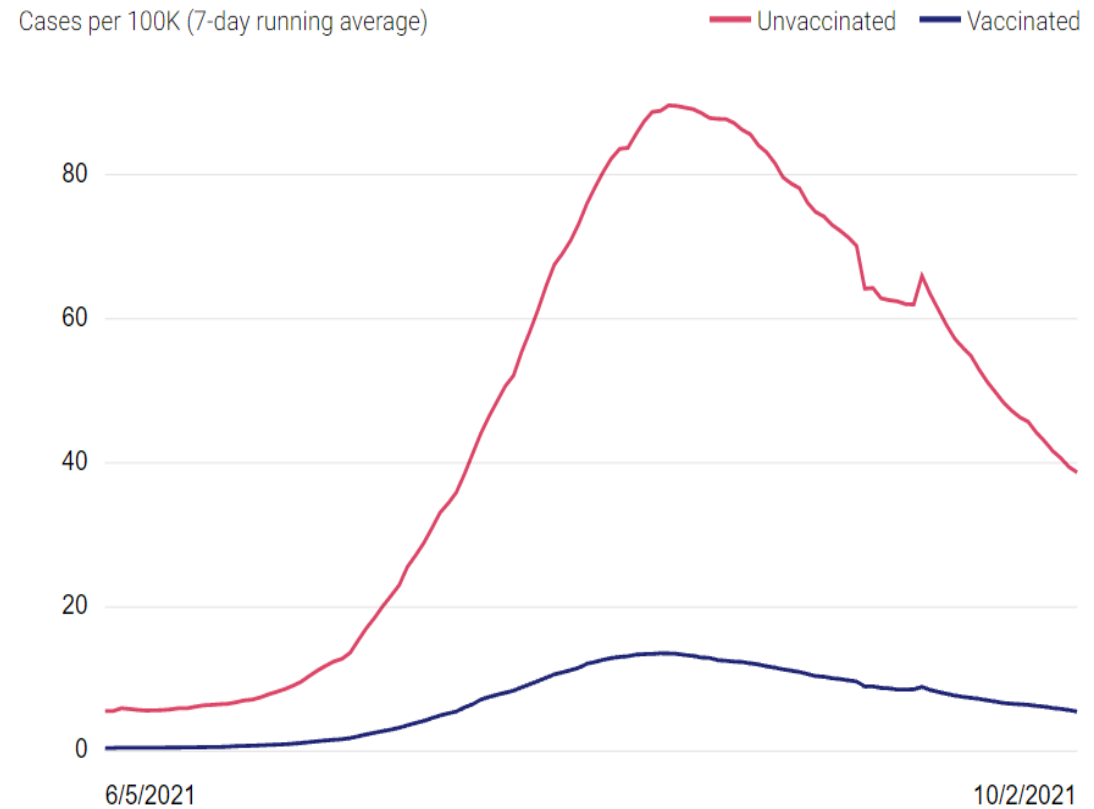

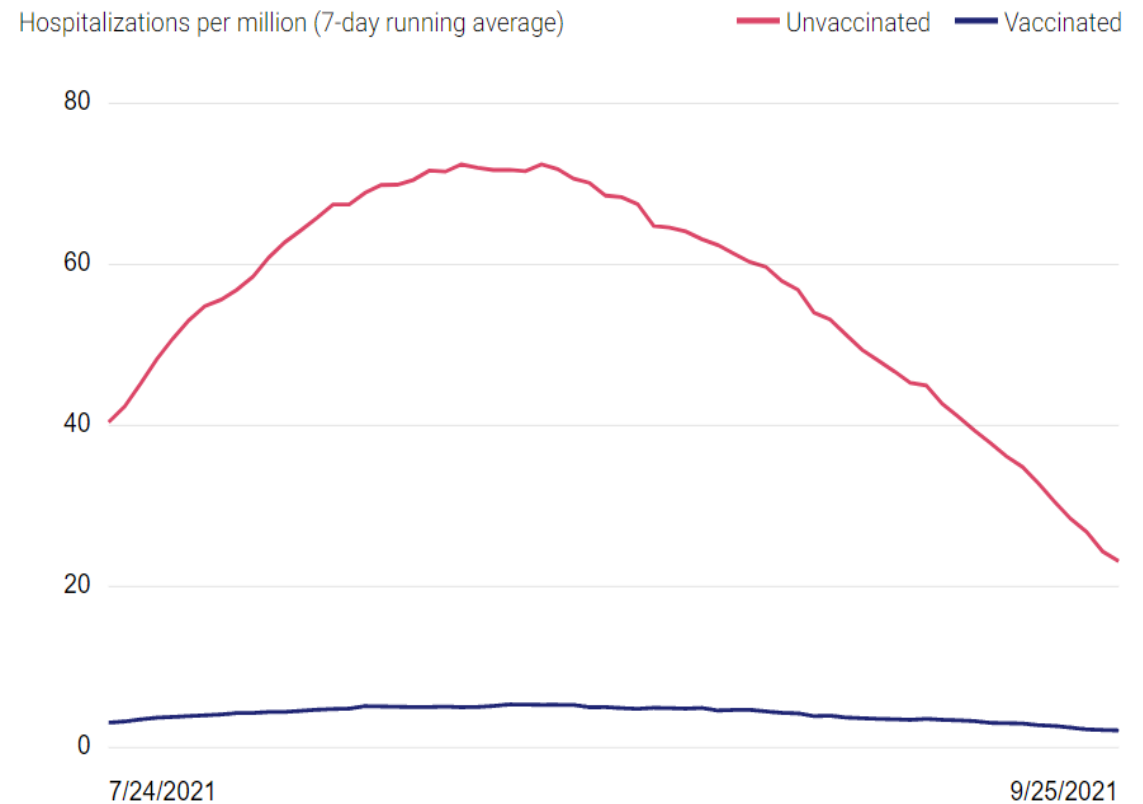
# STATE VACCINATED AND UNVACCINATED DATA

From September 26, 2021 to October 2, 2021, unvaccinated people were **7.0 times more likely** to get COVID-19 than fully vaccinated people.



# STATE VACCINATED AND UNVACCINATED DATA

From September 19, 2021 to September 25, 2021, unvaccinated people were **10.9 times more likely** to be hospitalized with COVID-19 than fully vaccinated people.

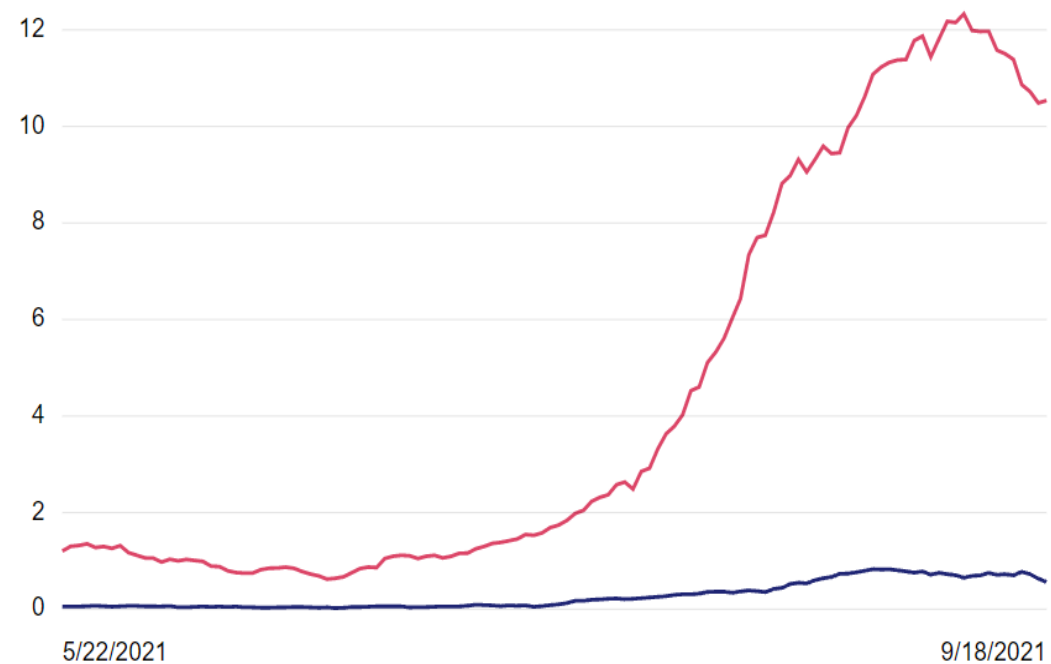


# STATE VACCINATED AND UNVACCINATED DATA

From September 12, 2021 to September 18, 2021, unvaccinated people were **18.7 times more likely** to die from COVID-19 than fully vaccinated people.

# PFIZER BOOSTERS FOR THE GENERAL POPULATION

- COVID-19 Vaccine booster shots are available for the following Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine recipients who completed their initial series at least 6 months ago:
  - **65 years and older**
  - **18+ who have underlying medical**
  - **18+ who work in high-risk settings**
  - **18+ who live in high-risk settings**
- Moderna and J&J booster guidance expected soon but no date or information regarding eligibility

# PFIZER BOOSTERS FOR THE GENERAL POPULATION

- Last week the FDA approved booster shots for both Moderna and J&J Vaccines
- Now the process moves forward
- Announcement on mixed boosters expected soon.

## Day of vaccination

- Bring a form of documentation with your name that matches the name on your appointment. Acceptable forms include: a driver's license, pay stub or utility bill.
- If your vaccine requires a second dose, ask when it will be scheduled.
- Prepare to wait 15-30 minutes after your shot to make sure you don't have a reaction to the vaccine.
- After your shot make sure to get your vaccination card.

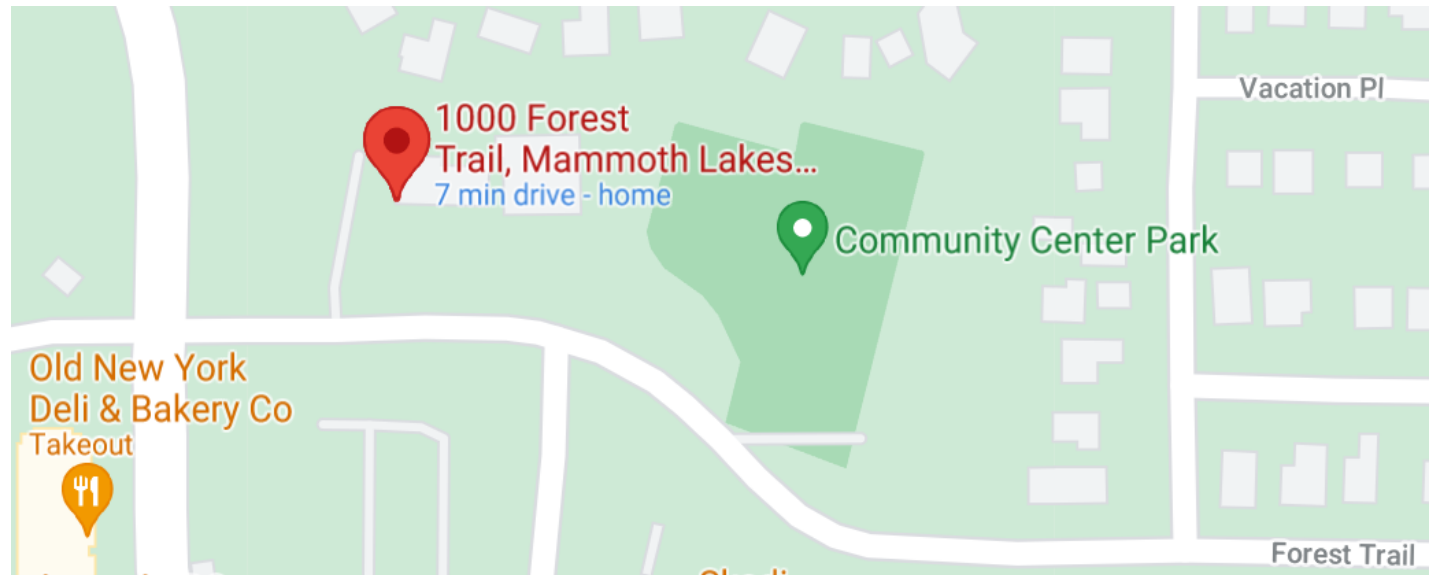
