

TOTAL POSITIVE CASES: 1352 (INCREASE IN CASES: 136 OR 11%)













Symptomatic vs Asymptomatic Breakthrough Cases

COVID VACCINE SCHOOL MANDATE

- California Becomes First State in Nation to Announce COVID-19 Vaccine Requirements for Schools
- After implementing first-in-the-nation school masking and staff vaccination measures, California becomes the first state to announce plans to require student vaccinations – adding the COVID-19 vaccine to list of vaccinations required for school, such as the vaccines for measles, mumps, and rubella
- Students will be required to be vaccinated for in person learning starting the term following FDA full approval of the vaccine for their grade span (7-12 and K-6).

MAMMOTH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT UPDATE

- Mammoth Middle School and Mammoth High school returned to in seat learning on Monday, September 27, 2021.
- The State outbreak response team and Mono County Public Health performed approximately 1,200 PCR and rapid Antigen tests to safely reopen schools.

LIMITED STATE RESOURCES AND INCREASED TESTING

- State resources, both human and material, remain in short supply.
- We continue to experience staffing shortages for response teams, testing sites, and contact tracing.
- Demand for testing remains high due to increased infection rate, school testing, and required workforce testing.

PFIZER BOOSTERS FOR THE GENERAL POPULATION

- COVID-19 Vaccine booster shots are available for the following Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine recipients who completed their initial series at least 6 months ago:
 - 65 years and older
 - 18+ who have <u>underlying medical</u>
 - 18+ who work in high-risk settings
 - 18+ who live in <u>high-risk settings</u>
- Moderna and J&J booster guidance expected soon but no date or information regarding eligibility

Day of vaccination

- Bring a form of documentation with your name that matches the name on your appointment. Acceptable forms include: a driver's license, pay stub or utility bill.
- If your vaccine requires a second dose, ask when it will be scheduled.
- Prepare to wait 15-30 minutes after your shot to make sure you don't have a reaction to the vaccine.
- After your shot make sure to get your vaccination card.


