# **Communication Objectives**

- Foster effective communication and trust between the Town of Mammoth Lakes and the community.
- Communicate the Town's messages in a unified voice, with clarity, integrity and consistency.
- Increase community awareness and comprehension of Town activities, programs, projects, products and services.
- Encourage the public to participate in community conversations or engage with the Town through a variety of communication channels.

## **Communication Functions**

- 1. Public Information
- 2. Community Relations
- 3. Web-based/Social Media Communication

### **Public Information**

**Purpose:** Public Information consists of the processes, procedures, and systems to communicate timely, accurate, and accessible information on an incident's cause, size, and current situation to the public, responders, media and additional stakeholders (crisis communication).

#### Tasks:

- Organizes and directs a unit within the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) supports the operation of a JIC or JIS.
- Develops and disseminates accurate and timely crisis communication to the public and media (PSA's, social media, subscription lists, etc.,)
- Monitors rumors and generates corrective information (social media)

# **Community Relations**

**Purpose:** Proactive communication to enhance the Town's relationship, visibility and public image within the community. Incorporates both media and community relations and the many methods utilized to establish and maintain a mutually beneficial relationship with the public.

#### Tasks:

- Creation and dissemination of Press Releases and Public Service Announcements
- Host interactive in-person or virtual community conversations for major incidents (COVID-19/Creek Fire) or for community events/programs.
- Creation and dissemination of FAQ's, featured stories, annual Town Accomplishments, Town e-News, communication plans for special projects (The Parcel, CRC, Airport, MUPS/Trails/Roads, etc.)

**Purpose:** Management and oversight of third-party web-based and social media communication platforms utilized by the Town to perform public information and community relation functions.


#### THE PARCEL
