

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF MAMMOTH LAKES, STATE OF  
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS IN THE  
AMOUNT OF \$344,273 FROM THE STATE OF  
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TOBACCO  
LAW ENFORCEMENT GRANT PROGRAM OVER  
FISCAL YEARS 2021-22, 2022-23, AND 2023-24**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Mammoth Lakes desires to participate in the Tobacco Law Enforcement Grant program, which is made available through the California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tax Act of 2016 (Prop. 56) and administered by the California Department of Justice to support efforts to reduce the illegal sale of tobacco products in the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mammoth Lakes Police Department submitted a proposal to participate in the grant program and the State of California Department of Justice awarded the Town \$344,273 for a three-year program covering December 1, 2021 through November 31, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant funds will be used for salary expenditures related to a School Resource Officer, educational opportunities for children, tobacco enforcement operations, local retailer inspections, training, and administrative costs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** the Town Council of the Town of Mammoth Lakes hereby authorizes the Chief of Police of the Mammoth Lakes Police Department to accept and expend the grant in the amount of \$344,273 from the California Department of Justice.
