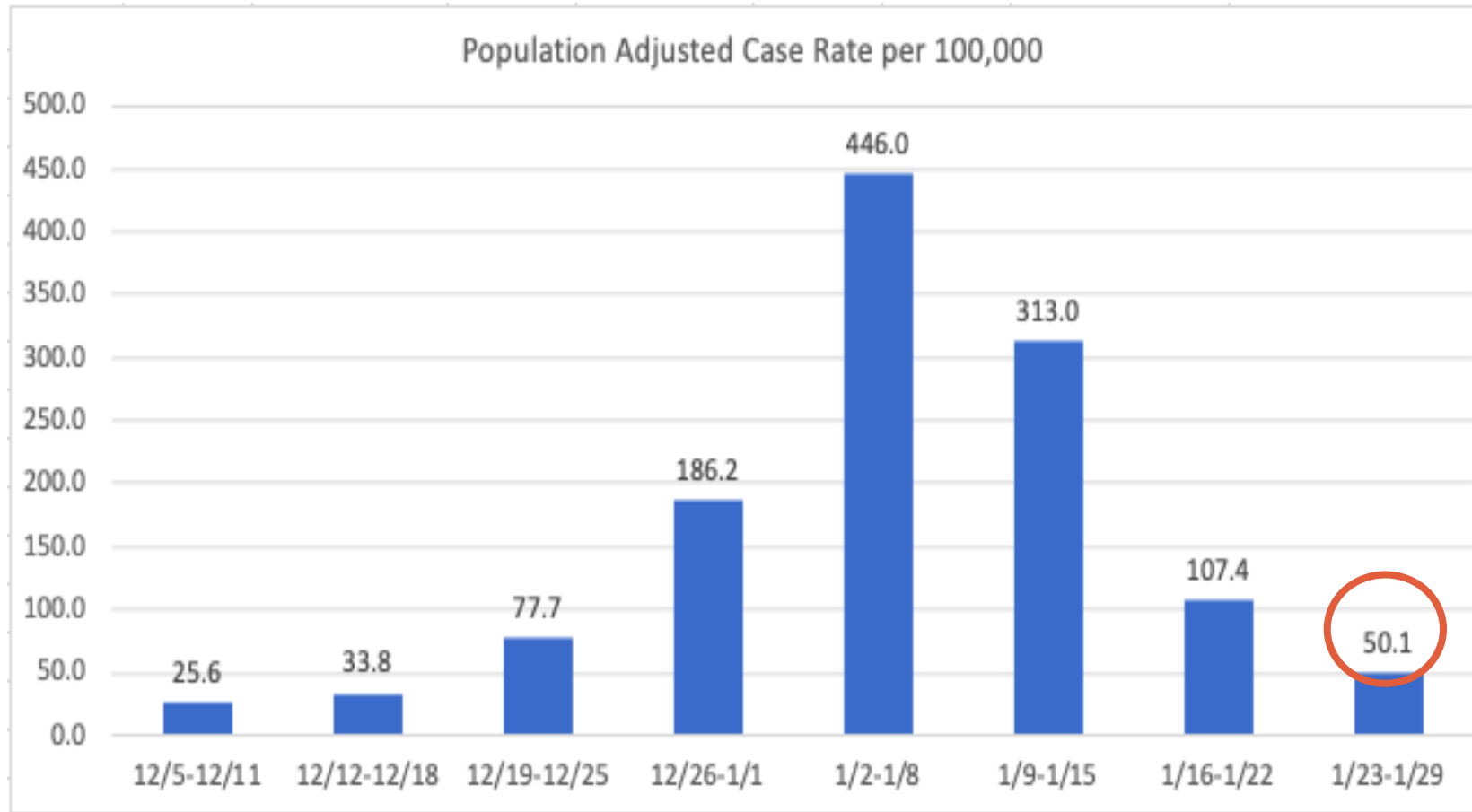


## Positive Lab Confirmed Results by Day for the Past 60 Days (Public)

- *Jan. 23 - 29: 49\**

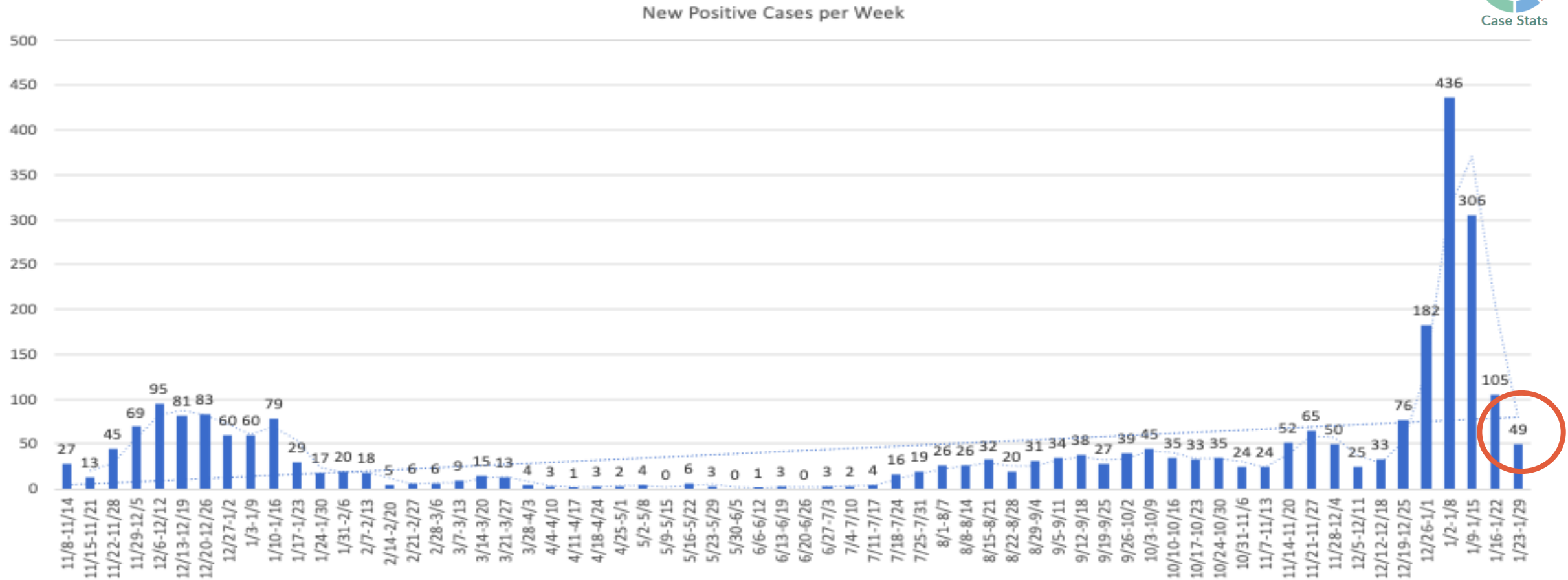
### Mammoth Hospital:

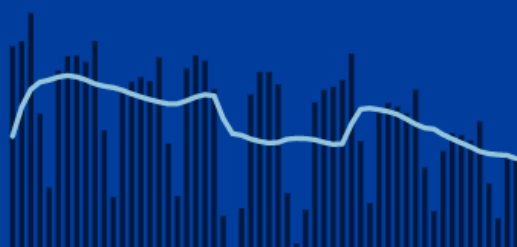

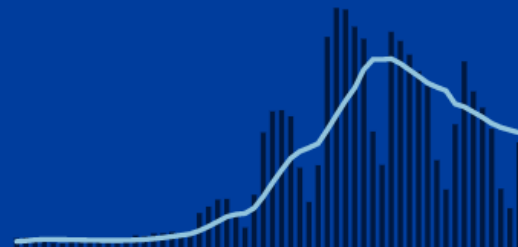

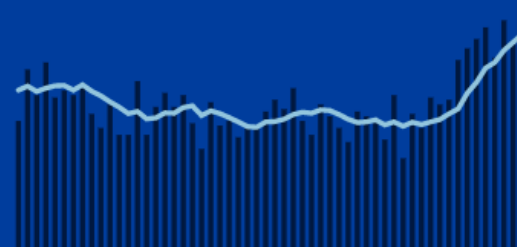

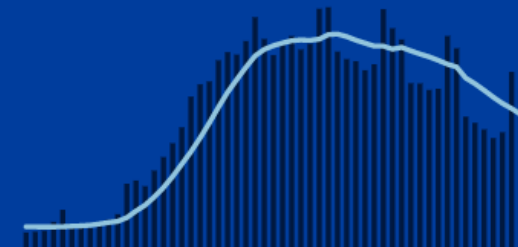

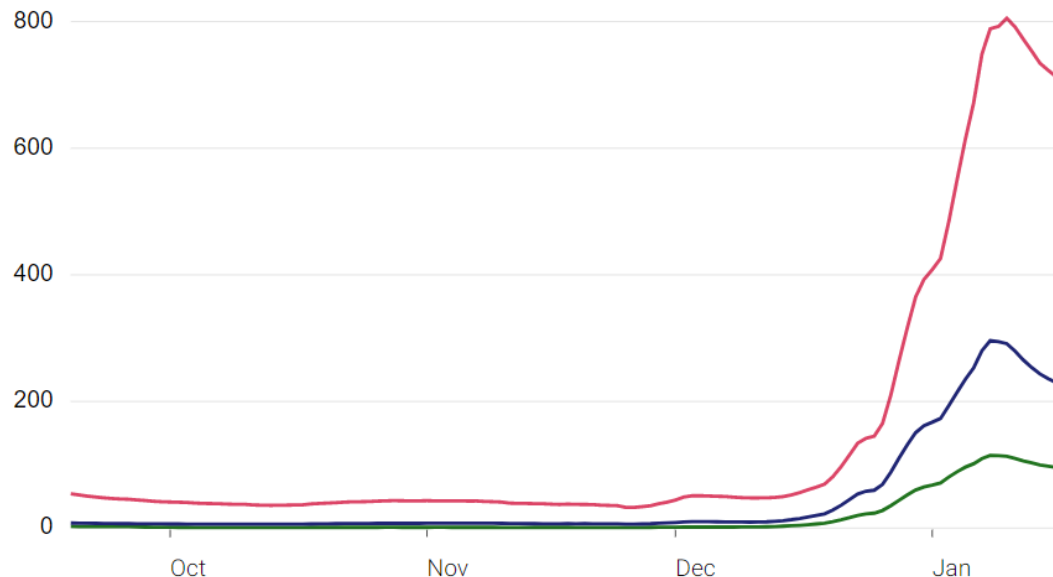

# VACCINE EFFECTIVENESS

- Vaccines prevent serious illness, save lives, and reduce further spread of COVID-19.
- As more people are vaccinated, the virus is less likely to spread, mutate, and potentially become even more dangerous. **Vaccines will help put an end to the pandemic.**
- Unvaccinated people were **7.5 times more likely** to get **COVID-19** than people who received their booster dose.
- Unvaccinated people are **14.0 times more likely** to be hospitalized with COVID-19 than fully vaccinated

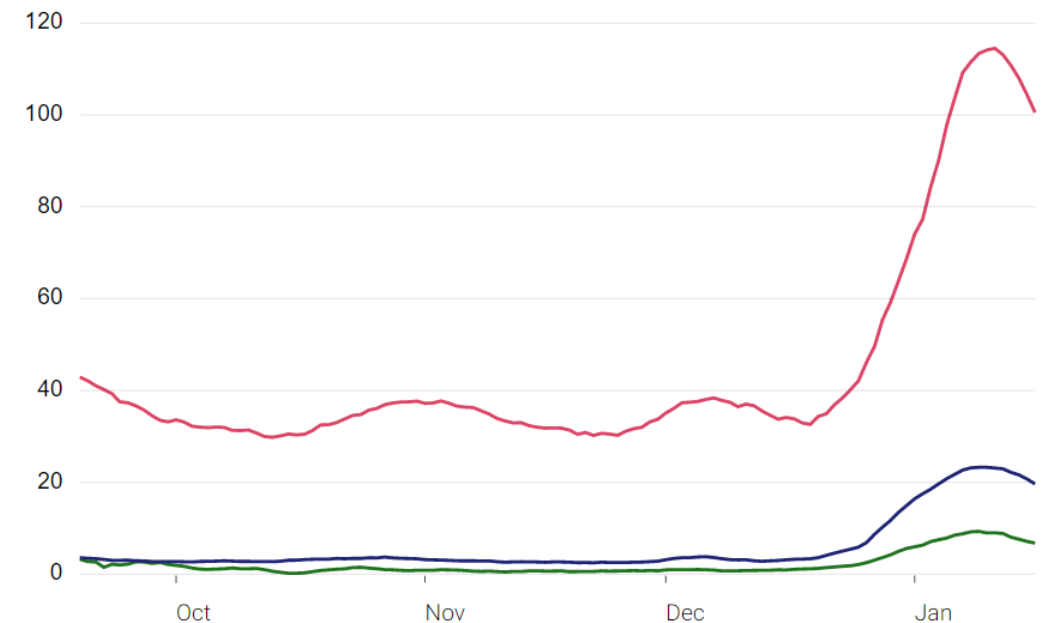
Cases per 100K (7-day running average)

\* Use of mRNA COVID-19 vaccines is preferred over the Janssen COVID-19 vaccine. However, the Janssen vaccine may be offered in some situations:

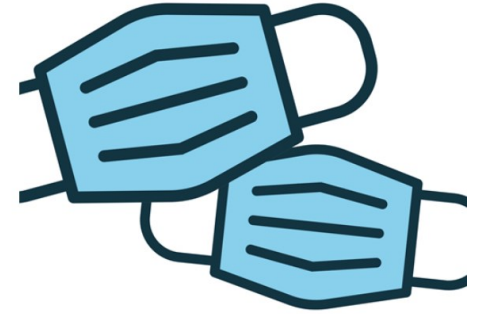
- When there is a contraindication to mRNA COVID-19 vaccines (e.g., severe allergic reaction after a previous dose or to a component of an mRNA COVID-19 vaccine)
- When a person would otherwise remain unvaccinated due to limited access to mRNA COVID-19 vaccines
- When a person wants to receive the Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine despite the safety concerns identified

# UNIVERSAL MASKING REQUIRED FOR ALL PUBLIC INDOOR SETTINGS



**Masks required**

- ✓ Masks are required to be worn in all indoor public settings irrespective of vaccine status through **February 15, 2022**, at which point California will make further recommendations as needed in response to the pandemic.
- ✓ Prior to attending an event, attendees will now require either proof of vaccination, a negative antigen COVID-19 test within one day of the event, or a negative PCR test within two days of the event.
- ✓ New travel advisory: all travelers arriving in California **test for COVID-19 within three to five days after arrival**, regardless of their vaccination status.

# UPGRADE YOUR MASK!

- Thanks for masking up, Mammoth Lakes!
- It's time to level up your protection against #COVID19. Choose a mask with good fit and filtration (N95 and KN95 masks are best). Double masking is also good (a surgical mask plus a cloth mask on top).
- Regardless of the mask type, it is only effective if it is **worn over your mouth and nose**.
- The least effective mask is a fabric mask with three or more cloth layers, while surgical masks or higher-level respirators (e.g., N95s, KN95s, KF94s) provide the best protection against COVID-19.

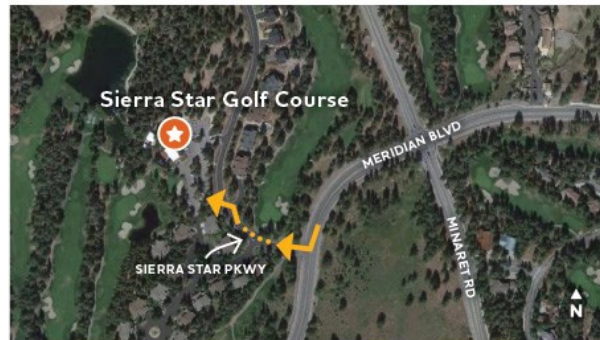

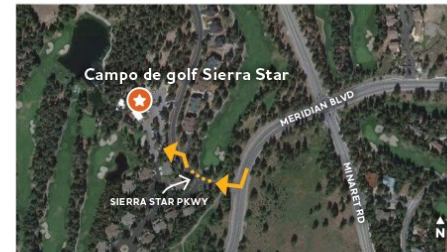

# FREE AT-HOME COVID-19 TESTS NOW AVAILABLE

Every home in the U.S. is now eligible to order four (4) free at-home COVID-19 tests from the federal government. The tests are completely free, and orders will usually ship in 7-12 days.

## ABOUT THE TESTS

- Rapid antigen at-home tests, not PCR
- Can be taken anywhere
- Results in 30 minutes (no lab drop-off required)
- Work whether or not you have COVID-19 symptoms
- Work whether or not you are up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines

## WHEN TO TEST

- If you begin having COVID-19 symptoms, including fever, sore throat, runny nose, or loss of taste or smell, or
- At least 5 days after you come into close contact with someone with COVID-19, or
- When you're going to gather with a group of people, especially those who are at risk of severe disease or may not be up to date on their COVID-19 vaccines
