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A RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULTS OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR COMMUNITY FACILITIES DISTRICT NO. 2021-1 (JUNIPER RIDGE MAINTENANCE SERVICES)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982, Chapter 2.5 of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 5, commencing with Section 53311, of the California Government Code (the "Act"), this City Council has adopted a resolution titled "A Resolution to Form Community Facilities District No. 2021-1 (Juniper Ridge Maintenance Services) and to Levy a Special Tax Therein to Finance Public Services in and for Such Community Facilities District" (the "Resolution of Formation"), ordering the formation of the Town of Mammoth Lakes Community Facilities District No. 2021-1 (Juniper Ridge Maintenance Services) (the "CFD"), authorizing the levy of a special tax on property within the CFD and preliminarily establishing an appropriations limit for the CFD;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Resolution of Formation and the Resolution of Necessity and pursuant to a resolution titled, "A Resolution Calling Special Election for Community Facilities District No. 2021-1 (Juniper Ridge Maintenance Services)" (the "Election Resolution") adopted by this City Council, the propositions of the levy of the special tax, the establishment of the appropriations limit were submitted to the qualified landowner electors of the CFD as required by the provisions of the Act;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Election Resolution, which are by this reference incorporated herein, the special election has been held in the CFD and the City Clerk has on file a Canvass and Statement of Results of Election (the "Canvass"), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, this City Council has reviewed the Canvass, finds it appropriate and wishes to complete its proceedings for the CFD.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAMMOTH LAKES RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are all true and correct.
- 2. The issues presented at the special election were the levy of a special tax within the CFD and the approval of an annual appropriations limit for the CFD, all pursuant to the Resolution of Formation.
- 3. The Council hereby approves the Canvass and finds that it shall be a permanent part of the record of its proceedings for the CFD. Pursuant to the Canvass, the issues presented at the special election were not approved by the qualified electors of the CFD by more than two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast at the special election, and therefore the measure fails.
- 4. In accordance with Section 53329 of the Act, because the measure has failed to receive approval by two-thirds of the votes cast, the City Council shall take no further action with respect to authorizing the specified special tax within the CFD for one year from the date of the election.
 - 5. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
