Title: ORMAT presentation on CD-IV Project and integration of the work program with planned and potential recreational uses

Summary: Representatives from ORMAT will provide an update on the CD-IV project. ORMAT is actively working to complete the installation of CD-IV Pipeline extending through the Shady Rest area to the ORMAT Plan on the east side of Highway 395. The Pipeline project presents potential opportunities to integrate remediation work, and disturbances with active recreational planning work. This would include analyzing an overlay of preliminary trails work done by the Town under an OHV grant, referred to as the Shady Rest Inyo Craters Planning Project (SRIC). To the extent the trails align with the disturbed areas created as part of the CD-IV project they may be established as part of the trail system network as part of the remediation efforts required of ORMAT.

Information on the status of the project, additional work to be completed, restoration plans, and operational requirements of the well sites and pipeline operations and need to access sites throughout the year. Staff is working with ORMAT on repair of damaged pavement in Shady Rest Park with plans to do repairs this spring. ORMAT is also planning for a ribbon cutting ceremony for the project and transition to normal operations.
