## **RESOLUTION NO. 22-**

## RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAMMOTH LAKES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CANYON BOULEVARD BETWEEN HILLSIDE AND LAKE MARY ROAD FOR THE MAMMOTH 50KM MTB PEDALPALOOZA EVENT ON AUGUST 27, 2022

WHEREAS, the Town of Mammoth Lakes desires to assist the private sector in the implementation of special events that increase visitation to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Mammoth 50km MTB PedalPalooza event will promote visitation and enhance the quality of life for residents of Mammoth Lakes; and

WHEREAS, the temporary Canyon Boulevard closure will enhance public safety and provide for emergency access to and through the event; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the net proceeds from the Mammoth 50km MTB PedalPalooza event will be donated to the Sierra Eastside Mountain Bike Association (SEMBA), a local non-profit organization for charitable uses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Mammoth Lakes, California, hereby:

- 1. Declares the program is not a project and is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act because it is a minor temporary use of land having negligible or no permanent effects on the environment per Section 15304 (e); and
- 2. Declares that Canyon Boulevard will be closed between Hillside Drive and Lake Mary Road on Saturday, August 27, 2022 from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. when all traffic control devices will be removed; and
- 3. Declares there is a public benefit from the Town facilitating the Mammoth 50km MTB PedalPalooza event; and
- 4. Authorizes `no parking' and traffic control equipment to be placed along the street prior to the event; and
- 5. Directs the Mammoth Lakes Police Department and Public Works Department to monitor the traffic within the event area and make any modifications that are deemed necessary for public safety.
