

Town Council of Mammoth Lakes Minutes of Special Meeting

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Mayor called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, 437 Old Mammoth Road, Suite Z, Mammoth Lakes.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Stacey Powells Lyster led the flag salute.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

John Urdi, Executive Director of Mammoth Lakes Tourism, gave an update regarding their special meeting discussion related to infrastructure priorities for the community.

Stacey Powells Lyster outlined snow storage issues in her neighborhood. She asked that Mill Street become a Town road.

Anne Gimpel said that all private roads should become Town roads. She outlined snow removal and snow storage issues on Mill Street.

Bobby Tanner, Reds Meadow Resort and Pack Station, outlined his concerns regarding the Reds Meadow Road Project and stewardship of the valley.

Sarah Sindell supported her neighbors' comments regarding Mill Street becoming a Town road.

4. **POLICY MATTERS**

4.1 <u>Council Action and Management Response to Extreme Weather</u> <u>Declared Emergency.</u>

Town Manager Daniel C. Holler introduced members of the emergency response team.

CalOES Assistant Chief/Coordinator Jeff Adams, Los Angeles County Deputy Chief Robert Harris, and Mammoth Lakes Fire Protection District Fire Chief Ales Tomaier gave an update regarding current emergency response activities.

Tom and Jason Sigler, Eastern Sierra Propane, outlined issues with snow on propane tanks.

Matthew Paruolo, Southern California Edison, outlined public safety issues around their infrastructure.

Councilmember Rea joined the meeting at 4:37 p.m.

Mr. Holler and Parks and Recreation Director Stuart Brown gave an update regarding the current emergency response.

There was discussion among members of Council, Chief Tomaier, and Mr. Paruolo.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Stacey Powells Lyster outlined her snow storage and propane tank issues.

Steve Searles spoke about animosity and distrust in the community.

There was discussion among members of Council and staff.

Karen O'Kelley asked about where the Town can truck snow to. Mr. Holler responded.

Moved by Councilmember Chris Bubser Seconded by Councilmember Sarah Rea Approve \$200,000 of matching funds to the Mammoth Mountain Community Foundation for emergency snow removal efforts.
