FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

MAY 2, 2023

On April 3, 2023, President Joseph R. Biden Jr., granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of California triggering the release of Federal funds to help individuals and communities recover from Severe Winter Storms, Straight-line Winds, Flooding, Landslides, and Mudslides that occurred February 21, 2023, and continuing. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:

PA-Designated Counties:	Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Del Norte , Fresno, Glenn , Inyo ,

San Benito, San Francisco, Santa Cruz, Sierra, Trinity, Tulare, and Tuolumne Counties.

(Assistance for actions taken to Hazard Mitigation (HM):

HM-Designated Areas: All areas in the State of California are

eligible to apply for assistance under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

OTHER: Additional designations may be made

at a later date if requested by the state

and warranted by the results of further damage assessments.
