Title: Determine that Emergency Work Authorized by Resolutions 23-29 and 23-54 continues to be necessary for public welfare and safety.

Recommended Motion: Council finds and determines that the emergency repair work authorized by Resolutions 23-29 and 23-54 continues to be necessary for public welfare and safety.

Summary:

Town facilities and infrastructure impacted by the extreme winter weather are still in a state of disrepair impacting the welfare and safety of the community. Damage to sidewalks, drainages, fencing, signage, and facilities is substantial. Staff has found additional damage to curbs and gutters, drain inlets, signage, fencing, facilities, ADA detectable surfaces, and sidewalks and repairs are necessary for public welfare and safety. On May 17, 2023, the Council adopted Resolution 23-29 authorizing the emergency repair of these damages and the procurement of the necessary equipment, services, and supplies for the repair, without a competitive bidding process. On July 12, 2023 the Council adopted Resolution 23-54, authorizing the emergency repair of these damages and the procurement of the necessary equipment, services, and supplies for the repair, without a competitive bidding process due to damages at the Mammoth Yosemite Airport. The need for the work authorized by these two resolutions continues to be necessary to provide for public welfare and safety. A copy of the resolutions is attached for Council information.
