Enclosed for your consideration are the priority projects of the Town of Mammoth Lakes for the FY2024 Inyo National Forest Program of work. The following document has been presented to, and approved by, Town Council. The Town's priority projects that will require additional Inyo National Forest Resources, specifically for NEPA related work include:

- 1) Continued Sherwin's Meadow (SHARP) trail planning and implementation
- 2) Extension of "Snow Pit" Use Permit and longer-term land tenure.
- 3) Collaborative efforts on Fuels Management.
- 4) Mammoth Creek Park East – Bike Park
- 5) Acquisition of USFS Land surrounding Mammoth Yosemite Airport – Townsite Act or other Land Conveyance mechanism.

The projects noted on the page of the attached, with subsequent pages highlighting current agreements, operations, and future proposals. We continue to be excited for the future and being able to work together meeting goals of the USFS and the expectations all of us who enjoy recreating on our public lands.
