Grants: NTIA BEAD

- NTIA Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment Program
- Last-Mile Construction
- BEAD Restructuring Policy Notice (June 6)
 - Benefit of the Bargain round (July 19 – August 2)
 - Final Proposal Submission Deadline: September 4
- Still “All Unserved Locations”
- Now “Least Expensive Solution”

 - Discussions of Slightly Modified Program Objectives





Legacy Grants: CAF II


- FCC Connect America Fund Phase II
- Funded with 25Mbps/3Mbps Service Requirement
- Project Areas Funded by CAF II are Not Eligible for BEAD
- 10-Year Program, Awards in 2018
- Geolinks & Viasat Project Areas





Legacy Grants: RDOF

- FCC Rural Digital Opportunity Fund
- Funded with 25Mbps/3Mbps Service Requirement
- Project Areas Funded by RDOF are Not Eligible for BEAD
- 10-Year Program, Awards in 2018 & 2019
- Frontier Project Areas Only





Broadband Expansion Outlook

- FCC Notice July 17, 2025:
 - Solicit Comments on Continued Use of 100Mbps/20Mbps Benchmark
 - Abolish long-term goal of 1Gbps/500Mbps Benchmark
 - Continue to use FCC BDC as the Primary Data Source
 - <https://docs.fcc.gov/public/attachments/DOC-413059A1.pdf>
- Online Innovation Requires Reliable Broadband
- Reliable, Symmetrical Gigabit Service should be the Goal
- Will Need Additional Broadband Expansion Iterations
